### **Re-Enrollment**

ONE WEEK TO GO before Re-registration fees go to \$250 per child. If you've already registered...GREAT, if not, we NEED your commitment in order to hold your spot vs. new enrollees. There is very strong interest in Dayspring, especially at the Kindergarten level. PreK4 families really need to re-enroll for Kindergarten NOW. We already have 2+ full Kindergarten classes and could have as many as 4. As classroom space is limited we may be forced to turn away students. REMEMBER that the registration fee is \$150.00 until April 1<sup>st</sup>. After that date we open enrollment and notify all applicants concerning acceptance. About half of our elementary students are yet to re-enroll...where are you? Please refer a new second grader and get a special finders bonus if they come (DCA had a low PreK year 3 years back creating this situation). We do have financial aide for those who qualify. We believe that DCA could realize record attendance.

### **Fund Raising**

**Floor Us:** Continues on working to have all classrooms done during the summer. We are adding the **PAPER RETRIEVER®** program, whereby all families can bring paper (NO CARDBOARD) for recycling to the school to drop into a special bright green/yellow container located in front of the school, to the right of the church. DCA will receive \$'s per ton after every pick-up with the proceeds going to complete the floors. EVERY family can participate and bring at least a container of paper for recycling, every week. It's an easy way to help DCA projects and ALL can participate.
