1. Write a poem that includes all main events of the novel. Think about characters, conflict, etc..
2. Create a theme song with lyrics for the novel. Think about events, people, plot, etc.
3. Make a cliffhanger commercial for the novel to persuade others to read it.
4. Rewrite an important scene or chapter from a different character's perspective.
5. Make a book cover different from the actual cover. Tell why you designed it that way.
6. Create a series of 5 Instagram posts for one or two characters in the novel.
7. Create a collage of main events, characters, places, etc. in the novel.
8. Answer the response questions (below.)

**Response Questions:**

1. If you could trade places with one of the characters, which one would it be and why?
2. Was there a character you didn't like? Why didn't you like this character?
3. What do you think was the best part of the story?
4. What was the worst part of the story?
5. If you could step into this story, what is the first thing you would do?
6. Choose one character and explain why you would or would not want to have him/her as a friend in real life.
7. In what ways are you like any of the characters in this novel. Explain.
8. Select a quote from your reading that you liked. Why did you pick it and what does it make you think about?
